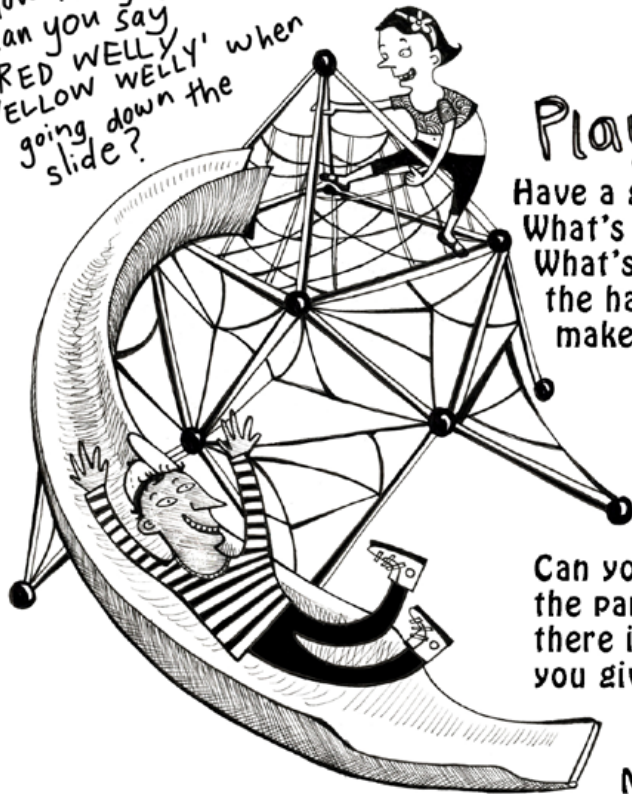

The Playground

THE → MAYPOLE

Traditionally a Maypole is decorated with ribbons whilst people dance around it.

PLAY HIDE & SEEK

With all the mounds in Netham Park, it's a perfect spot for playing hide and seek. Who can find the best hiding places? Time how long it takes for your partner to find you. There are also some fun variations you can play:

SARDINES



If you have a group of people, choose one person to hide. The rest of you try to find them, but when you do, you hide together! The last person to find the group hides next time!

FORTY FORTY

For this you need to choose a base. One person is 'it' and stays at the base and counts up to 40 (eyes closed!) Meanwhile everyone else hides. The aim is to get back to the base without being seen by the 'counter'.

Shout 'forty forty in' if you get back to the base unseen. If you are seen by the counter, then you race each other back to the base. If the counter gets to base first they shout 'forty forty I see'. If the hider gets back to base first they are saved. The last player back to base is 'it' next time.
